LITERACY IN MOZAMBIQUE

Mozambique has a population of 21 million, and became independent from Portugal in 1975. Portuguese is the official language, however many languages including Swahili, Makhuwa, Sena, Ndau and Shangaan are also spoken.

Primary school education is compulsory for children in Mozambique, however most do not attend school. Instead they have to work on their families subsistence farms for a living. This is the main contributing factor for the 70% illiteracy rate in most areas.

Through this project, the Bible Society is seeking to offer reading skills to the disadvantaged population, both Christians and non-Christians. Rural communities will be offered this literacy project, and teachers will be trained to undertake this task.

New Reader Scripture Booklets will be used to teach children and adults how to read in their own language. Supporting literacy workbooks are being developed and will also be used.

At the end of the 12 month literacy program, graduates will be presented with their own copy of the Bible.
